

## H.I.P.L. PLAYER AWARDS TALLY

The H.I.P.L. takes great pride in being able to offer and promote performance based awards in the form of patches, trophies and general recognition to our players throughout each session. These awards have expanded along with our growth and presently include:

- Break & Run (B&R)- Patches for each
- 8 on Break- Patches for each
- MVP for each of the 3 handicap groups- typically trophies
- Overall Most Improved Player (MIP)- typically a trophy
- Overall Most Effective Break (MEB)- typically a trophy
- A special numbered trophy for a player's first "CLEAN SWEEP"
- Special recognition in our news upon breaking an existing record

We also maintain a historical HIPL records database for those that would like to try breaking a record and having the recognition of seeing their name placed there. Check it out on our website! It's under the pull down menu under NEWS and ANNOUNCEMENTS then select "H.I.P.L. OFFICIAL RECORD BOOK".

Only one trophy will be issued per player and each will contain a unique serial number.
